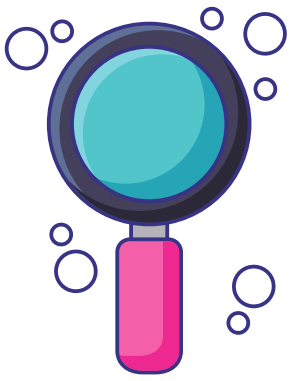
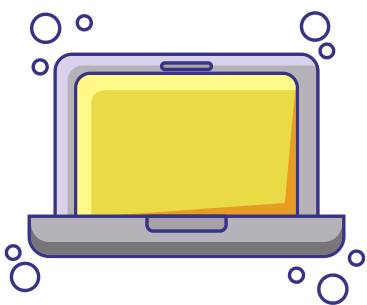


# RESULTS OF THE NPCPP SNAPSHOT SURVEY



## OUR SURVEY

Our Snapshot survey was open from Thursday, 16th April, closing on Wednesday, 22nd April at 5pm. A link to the survey was provided to parents' associations affiliated to the NPCPP, as well as post-primary schools across Ireland. The survey was also shared on social media.



## YOUR RESPONSES

At closure over 30,000 responses had been received from parents and guardians. In recognition of the fact that responses may have been received from others, a margin of error of approximately 10% should be accounted for.



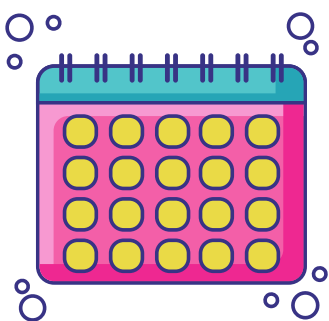
## JUNIOR CYCLE EXAMS

Over 14,500 respondents indicated that they have a student set to complete Junior Cycle examinations in the current academic year. When asked if respondents were happy with the announcement from the Department of Education and Skills on April 10th 2020, referring to the the deferral of the Junior Cycle Exams, 60% indicated that the deferral was acceptable, and 47% noted that the mode of examination was appropriate.



## LEAVING CERTIFICATE

Over 19,000 responses were received from parents and guardians of students completing the Leaving Certificate, LCVP, and LCA exams. 71% of respondents indicated that they were not in favour of the DES decision to defer these examinations to later in the Summer.



## EXAM POSTPONEMENT

From our survey we identified that the majority of parents and guardians of students completing examinations in 2020 do not deem the Department of Education and Skills decision to postpone examinations until late Summer and early August 2020 as appropriate.



## YOUR CONCERNS

Almost 8,000 additional comments were received from parents and guardians of students due to complete Junior Cycle exams, with over 14,000 comments received from parents and guardians in relation to Leaving Certificate, LCVP, and LCA exams. Comments were received noting concerns relating to student wellbeing, issues relating to disadvantages experienced in learning at home, and requests for alternative solutions for for the assessment of students in 2020.
